Ride on the Right Side of the Road

Go with the flow. It's safer and it's the law.

Be Predictable — But Don't Expect Drivers to Be!

Ride in a steady straight line. Don't make assumptions about what drivers are going to do or even that they see you.

Stay Alert

Watch for car doors opening, pedestrians, and turning vehicles. Don't wear headphones or use a phone. Check your rear-view mirror.

Use a Helmet

A helmet greatly reduces the risk of serious injury. Always wear one when riding.

Use Lights and Reflectors

At night or in low light, use a white front light, a red rear light, and reflectors so others can see you. Use the rear-view mirror to improve awareness of traffic behind you.

Follow Traffic Laws

Obey stop signs, traffic lights, and lane markings. Bicycles and e-bikes must follow the same rules as cars.
